

5 - Sometimes being a parent can be the toughest job there is, and this can affect our relationships. Theraplay Families is a 6-week programme that focuses on enhancing the connection, trust and joy between you and your child.

Theraplay Families is an online course via Teams for parents/carers of children 8 years and under.

Starting Tuesday 16th September 10.30 – 11.30 for 6 weeks the course includes:

- Introduction to Theraplay
 - Structure and Nurture
- Relationship Stress and Challenge activities
 - Sensory Processing
 - Theraplay and Emotional Regulation
- Theraplay Families—putting it all together
